**ORDER**

Deepak Foundation, Vadodara is hereby awarded the work to make District hospital Alirajpur and CHC Jobat, in district Alirajpur fully functional as CEMONC facility as per the MOU signed with Deepak foundation on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2015 for three years ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018, copy of the MoU is enclosed. The details of the activities to be carried out are as under:

1. To ensure services of Anaesthetist, Gynaecologist and Paediatrician round the clock at DH Alirajpur and CHC Jobat.
2. Ultrasound facility at DH Alirajpur and CHC Jobat.

Funds for the above mentioned activities would be made available to the districts as per provisions made in the PIP 2015-16. The foundation would contribute towards strengthening of services and provide top up in each activities as per need.

**Provision of funds to Deepak Foundation:**

1. All payments shall be made through District Health Society, Alirajpur.
2. For hiring of specialists in CEmONC facilities by Deepak foundation, honorarium will be reimbursed to Deepak foundation on monthly basis as per NHM norms i.e, Rs 75000/ per month for diploma holders and Rs 85,000/ per month for degree holders at DH, Rs 90,000/ per month for diploma holders and Rs 1,00,000/ per month for degree holders at CHC Jobat, after the posting of specialists.
3. For USG services, payment will be done on per case basis at the rate of maximum Rs 300/- per USG on monthly basis from JSSK fund.

**Terms and conditions to be followed:**

1. Specialist hired for providing services will follow NHM HR contractual employee norms in terms of leave, maternity leave, conduct rules and Breach of contract. Contract for hiring of specialist will be signed in between doctors and Deepak foundation. Remuneration and perks of doctors will be decided by Deepak Foundation.
2. Services mentioned should be provided round the clock and as per guideline. Leave if needed, should be communicated well in advance to district authorities and alternate arrangement must be ensured.
3. Reimbursement of honorarium will be done based on the attendance and performance duly certified by facility incharge. Performance of specialist will be assessed based on GOI criteria i.e, minimum 10 c section per month to maximum 10% of deliveries in institution.

4. Financial Audit will be done by the department.
5. USG services should be provided as per PC & PNDD norms.
6. **This work order is being issued to Deepak foundation initially for current financial year i.e, upto 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, and subsequent work order will be issued for next financial years based on sanctions in NHM PIP.**
7. Reports of services provided should be communicated in writing to district authority with a copy to state and division offices on monthly basis.
