Subject: Identification of Land for establishing new Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) and Eklavya Model Day Boarding Schools (EMDBS) - reg

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, EMRSs have been one of the flagship interventions of the Ministry to provide quality middle and high-level education to Scheduled Tribe (ST) students in remote areas. The Ministry, so far, has sanctioned 284 EMRSs out of which 219 EMRSs have become functional. The list of the EMRSs is at **Annexure-I**. Government of India have now decided that by the year 2022, every block with more than 50% ST population and at least 20,000 tribal persons, will have an Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS). These EMRSs will be on par with Navodaya Vidyalayas and will have special facilities for preserving local art and culture besides providing training in sports and skill development. A brief of the proposed changes in the Scheme is at **Annexure-II**.

2. Across the country, as per census 2011 figures, there are 564 sub-districts i.e. blocks/taluka/tehsil having more than 50% ST population and at least 20,000 tribal persons. Out of these sub-districts, at present 102 sub-districts have EMRSs.

3. Wherever density of ST population is higher in identified Sub-Districts/Blocks (90% or more), it is proposed to set up Eklavya Model Day Boarding School (EMDBS) on an experimental basis for providing additional scope for ST Students seeking to avail school education without residential facility. Accordingly, 12 such EMDBS will be set up at unit cost of Rs. 14.00 Crores per school based on the demand of the State Government. The features of EMDBS will remain the same as EMRS except for the following:

- i. No residential facility.
- ii. Land requirement – 5 acres.
- iii. Provision of morning snacks, lunch and evening snacks
- iv. Transportation facility in convergence with States.
- v. Recurring cost @ Rs. 85000 per student per year.

4. It is proposed to establish new Schools (450 EMRS and 12 EMDBS) in the remaining 462 sub-districts by the year 2022 as per the following order of priority:

- a. Priority Districts (more than 50% ST population and more than 20,000 ST population) but not having an EMRS. Any sub-district in these districts may be identified as per the availability of land. List of 19 such districts is at **Annexure-III**.
- b. Districts having sub-districts with more than 50% ST population and more than 20,000 ST population but not having EMRS. List of these districts along with the Sub-District is at **Annexure-IV**.
- c. Wherever density of ST population is higher in identified Sub-Districts/Blocks (90% or more), Eklavya Model Day Boarding School (EMDBS) will be setup. The list of the Sub-Districts identified are at **Annexure-V**.
- d. Thereafter Sub-Districts (i.e. block/taluka/tehsil) having more than 20,000 ST population and 50% STs subject to essential parameters like availability of land, educational backwardness etc will be taken up. Complete list of 462 blocks having more than 20,000 ST population and more than 50% ST population and not having an EMRS is at **Annexure-VI**.
- e. Proposals for setting up of dedicated infrastructure for establishing Centre of Excellence for sports with all related infrastructure (buildings, equipment's etc.). These Centre of Excellences will have specialized state-of-the-art facilities for one identified individual sport and one group sport in each State. 15 such centres will be established during 2018-19 to 2019-20.

5. You are hereby requested to identify land (minimum of 15 acres for EMRS and 5 acres for EMDBS) as per the order of priority mentioned in para 4. The confirmation regarding the identification of the land sub-district-wise along with a brief proposal for establishing these Schools may be submitted to be the Ministry latest by 8th January, 2019. The proposals from the State Governments and wayforward for implementation of the new approved norms are slated for discussion tentatively in the meeting being scheduled on 17th January, 2019 at Hyderabad, Telangana under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Tribal Affairs, Government of India This is required to be attended to by you and for this a separate communication will follow.

It is requested that receipt of this letter be acknowledged and necessary proposals in this regard are expedited.
